

Statement From Maryland LEHS, Department of Natural Resources Via email; June 2024

"Septic tanks in the State need to meet the requirements of COMAR 26.04.02 and if they do, they are in general terms allowed to be used.

Poly/roto-molded tanks are also approvable as long as they meet those standards. It is up to the local Approving Authority to determine suitability, and while we do not maintain a list outside of those produced by BAT manufacturers, some local jurisdictions may."
