The Division of Water Quality (Division) has completed its review of plans 1 for the Valencia Pipe Company 1,000 and 1,500 gallon single and dual-compartment high-density polyethylene (HDPE) septic tanks received on May 23, 2024. These plans and specifications basically comply with septic tank construction requirements listed in Utah Administrative Code R317-4-14, Appendix A and are hereby approved. The Division has retained construction plans and specifications in our files for future reference. A *List of Approved Septic Tanks and Manufacturers* is distributed to local health departments periodically and is available to the public online at https://documents.deq.utah.gov/water-quality/engineering/DWQ-2017-003211.pdf.
